Texas has a new voter ID requirements for the November General Election. As a result, voters now have **two** ways to show their identification at the polls.

1. Voters without photo identification.

Voters without photo identification can still vote. If you do not have a photo ID card, and you would have difficulty getting an ID card before Election Day, you can sign a special form at the polling place called a "Reasonable Impediment Declaration."

Reasonable impediments include lack of transportation, disability or illness, lack of birth certificate or other documents needed to obtain acceptable photo ID, work schedule, family responsibilities, lost or stolen photo ID, or photo applied for but not received. You may also describe another reasonable impediment not listed on the Reasonable Impediment Declaration form.

Election officials **may not** question the reasonableness of your difficulty in getting identification.

Voters who lack photo identification must still present some other type of document. These alternatives are:

- Valid voter registration certificate
- Certified birth certificate
- Current utility bill
- Bank statement
- Government check
- Paycheck
- Any other government document with your name and an address (original required if it contains a photograph)

You can present these documents and sign a Reasonable Impediment Declaration. The address on your ID does not have to match the address on your voter registration.

2. Voters with photo identification.

Voters who have the following forms of photo ID must present that photo ID:

- Texas driver license issued by the Texas Department of Public Safety (DPS)
- Texas Election Identification Certificate issued by DPS
- Texas Personal identification and card issued by DPS
- Texas license to carry a handgun issued by DPS
- United States military identification card containing the person's photograph
- United States citizenship certificate containing the person's photograph
- United States passport

With the exception of the U.S. citizenship certificate, the identification must be current or have expired no more than 4 years before being presented for voter qualification at the polling place.


