Coke County Treasurer Stephanie Samaniego and County Auditor Jennifer Henderson reported that the audit is underway and urged elected officials to complete their audit questionnaires.

Judge Spain notified the Court of Early Voting Hours for the week ahead and briefly discussed abatement guidelines. He also reported that the West Texas Legislative Conference will take place on August 6th.

Judge Spain recessed the meeting at 10:04 am.

Judge Spain and the County Commissioners went into executive session at 10:05 am.

The executive session was adjourned at 10:48 am.
